

The Flexitouch Plus system uses a programmable controller that connects to a garment with built-in air chambers. The garment inflates and deflates in a specific order, creating a gentle, wave-like motion. This mimics manual lymph drainage, moving excess fluid from the swollen area toward healthier parts of the body where it can be absorbed.



FLEXITOUCH PLUS TREATMENT OVERVIEW

Your program may or may not include the decongestion phase (teal)

- **Trunk:** directs fluid from the groin toward the waist; cycle repeats
- **Thigh:** directs fluid from the knee toward the top of the thigh; cycle repeats
- 3 Calf: directs fluid from the ankle toward the knee; cycle repeats
- 4 Foot: directs fluid from the foot toward the ankle; cycle repeats
- **Full Leg and Trunk:** directs fluid from the toes to the waist in one continuous motion; cycle repeats


