Carry-on Bag

If you're bringing your pump in your carry-on, we recommend using one of our Tactile Medical bags, or a small, hard-sided bag.

- Include your power cord and any accessories.*
- Bring your prescription card with you.
- Check with your airline to ensure your medical device will not be counted as a carry-on item. This will enable you to bring other items on board.
- Tactile Medical bags are designed to carry your controller, garment, and accessories. You can purchase these bags at shop.tactilemedical.com.

Checked Bag


If you're packing your pump in a checked bag, we recommend using one of our Tactile Medical bags, or a hard-sided suitcase. Consider wrapping your compression garments around your pump to protect it. Keep in mind, if your bag is checked as a medical bag, most airlines will not allow other items inside, such as clothing or toiletries.

- Include your power cord and any accessories.*
- Bring your prescription card with you.
- Ask your airline carrier to place a "FRAGILE" sticker on your bag to ensure it is handled with care.
- The Nimbl[™] rechargeable battery must be packed in your carry-on.
- Tactile Medical bags are designed to carry your controller, garment, and accessories. You can purchase these bags at shop.tactilemedical.com.

Note: The warranty on your pump is voided if it becomes damaged during handling by the airline.

TSA Checkpoint Screening Tips

Use these suggestions to help you get through the security checkpoint as smoothly as possible:

- Have your TSA Notification Card, otherwise referred to as a Disability Card, ready to show the TSA officer.
- 2. Inform the TSA officer that you are traveling with your pump and where it is located in your baggage.
- 3. Remove your pump from your bag for screening; the x-rays will not damage your device.
